

Lawton City Council Minutes

January 17, 2006

The Lawton City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, January 17, 2006, at Lawton City Hall. Council members answering roll: Don Grigg, Tony Bengford, Rick Schorg, Terry Masching and Perry Ludwig. Mayor Jeff Nitzschke called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and welcomed guests.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss request from Mark Richardson and Spencer Griffith asking Council to grant a one year extension on development time frame as spelled out in Resolution #2003-05 regarding property the two of them own located in 300 block of Cedar Street. Commonly known address for this property is 305, 307 and 311 Cedar Street, Lawton Iowa.

Richardson and Griffith informed Council of expected development within next several months. After much consideration, motion was made by Masching to grant 6-month extension. Motion died for lack of a second. Motion then made by Grigg to grant 1-year extension based on information provided. Masching seconded. On roll, motion carried 5-0.

Mayor brought attention to building concerns with Water Filtration Facility. Attorney will contact Kuehl & Payer with concerns.
