

Lawton City Council Minutes

May 26, 2009

The Lawton City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, May 26, 2009, at the Lawton City Hall. Meeting called to order at 5:00 pm by Mayor Jeff Nitzschke. Council members answering roll: Perry Ludwig, Don Grigg and Todd Roerig. Absent were Rick Schorg and Terry Masching. Others attending were City Clerk Patricia Washburn, Attorney Glenn Metcalf and Eric Hennings.

Motion to approve agenda was made by Ludwig, seconded by Grigg. Motion carried on roll 3-0.

Mayor welcomed guests.

Mayor opened Public Hearing at 5:01 p.m. regarding amendment to current 2009 Fiscal Year budget. Amendment was published in Movable Record for review on May 14, 2009 with all explanations of expense and revenue changes listed. No oral or written comments came to City Hall or to any of the councilmen prior to this Public Hearing. Motion made by Grigg, seconded by Roerig to close Public Hearing at 5:05 and approve **RESOLUTION #2009-06 BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009**. Motion carried on roll 3-0. Schorg and Masching absent. Full text of resolution is on file at City Hall.

Eric Hennings spoke to Council regarding possible site locations for business offices and warehouse. Hennings will investigate options further and keep in touch with Council.

Clerk informed Council of 29% increase in Work Comp premiums. Council discussed briefly what options could be taken. Matter will be discussed further at June meeting.

Council was informed of resident failing to keep grass and weeds mowed. Letter will be sent to owner regarding ordinance. City will mow if necessary. Costs will be assessed to owner.

With no further business to come before the meeting, meeting was adjourned at 5:50 pm.
