

Lawton City Council Minutes

August 16, 2005

The Lawton City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, August 16th, 2005, at Lawton City Hall. Council members answering roll: Perry Ludwig, Don Grigg, Terry Masching, and Tony Bengford. Rick Schorg was absent. Mayor Jeff Nitzschke called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and welcomed guests.

A Public Hearing was called to order regarding the plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of costs for construction of a water filtration facility. Presented to Council for inspection was an email received from Lawton resident Martin Shorman citing several personal recommendations and observations due to his professional experience as an engineer. The complete text of Shorman's email is on file at City Hall. No other written or oral communication was received regarding this project. Masching moved to close hearing. Grigg seconded. On roll motion carried 4-0.

Grigg moved to approve plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of costs for construction of water filtration facility as presented. Masching seconded. Motion carried on roll 4-0.

With no further business to come before the meeting, motion was made by Masching, seconded by Ludwig, to adjourn at 5:40 p.m. Carried 4-0.
