

Lawton City Council Minutes

October 18, 2005

The Lawton City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, October 18th, 2005, at Lawton City Hall. Council members answering roll: Tony Bengford, Perry Ludwig, Terry Masching and Don Grigg. Councilman Rick Schorg was absent. Mayor Jeff Nitzschke called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and welcomed guests.

The intent of this meeting was to authorize the Mayor to sign the water filtration contract, and to authorize the Mayor to sign the well drilling contract.

After Counsel affirmed suitable bid bond from Christiansen Construction Co. LLC of Pender, Nebraska, Grigg moved to authorize Mayor to sign contract with Christiansen Construction for construction of new water filtration facility. Ludwig seconded motion. Motion carried on roll 4-0. Neal Kuehl was present and stated all sub-contractors involved in pre-construction meeting stated they are ready to start construction. Insulated material is expected to be released for use within week.

Jerry Steffen was present and informed Council he did not have well drilling contract ready for Mayor's signature. Council tabled until November 1st meeting.

Building permit was approved for John Eblen, 516 Pine, dwelling. Eblen affirmed building will go no closer to lot pins than stated on permit application.

With no further business to come before the meeting, meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m
