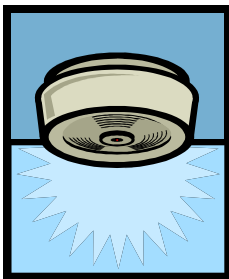

Water meter readings are generally taken around the 20th day of each month.
Invoices for water, sewer, garbage and landfill are sent on the 1st of each month.
These invoices are delinquent if not paid by the 20th of that same month.
A 10% Late Fee will be assessed on all delinquent accounts.

ESTIMATED READINGS

Most of your water meter readings were estimated this month. The April invoice will be with "actual" readings again, and will bring you up-to-date. Please call City Hall if you are concerned with the estimate you have been given.



SMOKE ALARM BATTERIES

It is recommended that we change our smoke alarm batteries every six months. The first day of Spring and the first day of Fall are two easy days to associate with changing smoke alarm batteries. Protect your family. Change batteries now.

Iowa Network Services, Inc. Grant Western Iowa Telephone Grant

The City of Lawton was notified in February that we had been chosen as a grant recipient in the amount of \$1,000 from Iowa Network Services, Inc. In a matching grant, Western Iowa Telephone Association also awarded the City an additional \$1,000 grant.

The grant was applied for as assistance in replacing the wooden playground equipment in the Tara Way Park.

Several years ago the city's insurance carrier recommended that the wooden playground equipment be replaced for safety reasons. New equipment has already been installed in the Veterans' Memorial Park downtown. Hopefully Tara Way Park will sport new equipment this summer.
