PET LICENSES



ALL dogs and cats are required to be licensed through the city. Cost is \$5 for spayed or neutered animals and \$10 for non-spayed or non-neutered animals. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be presented prior to tags being issued. Current tags will expire June 30, 2008.

BUILDING PERMITS: Building permits are required for all outside projects except landscaping. Any type of outside structure such as an addition on your home, a storage shed, a fence...even pouring a concrete slab needs a building permit.

Applications are available online at the city website, or by coming into City Hall. Applications must be approved by the Mayor, Public Works Director and one Councilman before any construction or dirt work may begin.

Cost of a building permit is \$15. Additional fees apply if you need to have water or sewer hook ups.

IOWA ONE CALL: *Before doing any digging or disturbing of the ground, remember to call Iowa One Call at 1-800-292-8989.*

This is a necessary call even if you are simply planting trees or bushes. Iowa One Call will notify all area utility companies of the impending dig. Within 48 hours all utilities will come to your property and "locate" their underground lines.

If you dig before calling Iowa One Call and you happen to hit an underground line, it will be your responsibility to pay for the repairs.

SIOUXLAND COMMUNITY BLOODBANK: The Siouxland Community Bloodmobile will be taking blood donations on Tuesday, April 1st, 2008 from 2:00-6:00 pm at the Lawton-Bronson High School. Blood may be donated every 56 days. You must be healthy and feeling well the day of donation. If you have questions about donating blood, you can contact the Siouxland Blood Bank at 1-800-798-4208.
