It's that time of year again to LICENSE YOUR PET!

Current pet tags expire on June 30th. City code requires all dogs and cats over the age of 3 months to be registered with the city. Spayed or neutered pets are \$5 each, intact pets are \$10. Proof of current rabies vaccination is needed at the time of registration. The penalty for failure to register your pets is \$3 per pet the first month, then \$25 per pet each month thereafter.
