

It's that time of year again to LICENSE YOUR PET!

Current pet tags expire on June 30th. <u>City code requires all dogs and cats over the age of 3 months to be registered with the city</u>. Spayed or neutered pets are \$5 each, intact pets are \$10. Proof of current rabies vaccination is needed at the time of registration. The penalty for failure to register your pets is \$3 per pet the first month, then \$25 per pet each month thereafter. Pursuant to City Ordinance Code, Section 52.03, it is the duty of the owner or owners to cut or destroy weeds or grass that have exceeded twelve inches in height before they bloom or seed, and in any event, by the 15th day of the month from May through October.

Failure to comply with the provisions of Section 52.03 will result in the City Weed Commissioner mowing, cutting or removing the weeds, and the cost of the labor and material being billed to the landowner. Such cost will not be less than \$100 and is to be paid to the City of Lawton within thirty days. Failure to pay within 30 days will result in costs being added to property taxes.

Tentatively fireworks may be used beginning June 24 until July 8 this year. Permitted times for use shall be from 9am until 10pm on weekdays, and 9am until 11pm on July 3 and 4. Fireworks must be used on private property and are not allowed to be used on public streets, sidewalks, or parks. Violations of these rules are considered a Municipal Infraction and will incur a \$100 civil penalty for the first offense and \$200 for each subsequent offense within 6 months.
