Please remember grass and other yard debris in the street can create dangerous situations for riders!

Just a few things to remember...

-**Building permits** are required when any building, structure, retaining, wall, or fence is erected, constructed, enlarged, or improved. Structures includes but is not limited to homes, sheds, garages, pools, and decks. Permits can be found at city hall or online.

-**Golf carts and ATV/UTVs** must be operated by individuals who possesses a valid drivers license and only between sunrise and sunset. They are also NOT allowed on the walking trail.

-**Trailers, campers, trucks, and dumpsters** are not allowed to be left on the city street except to load or unload for a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 36 hours.

-**Grass and Weeds** shall be cut or destroyed that have grown to a height of 12 inches, and in any event, by the 15th day of each month from May to October. Grass clippings may be included in your regular trash pickup.

-**Recyclables** need to be in CLEAR or see-through bags and set at the curb. Please do not include pizza boxes, glass, grass clippings, clothing, or styrofoam. If they see any of these items they CANNOT TAKE YOUR CAN!

-Please **do not discard items down your toilets**. Items like diapers, feminine hygiene products, grease, contraceptive products, flushable wipes, clothing, and paper towels, DO NOT BELONG in the sewer systems!

-Current **pet tags expire** at the end of June. City code requires all dogs & cats over 3 months of age be registered with the city. Spayed or neutered pets are \$5 each, intact pets are \$10. Proof of current rabies vaccination is needed at the time of registration. More info will be sent soon!



Fire Hydrants will be flushed **May 7-9**
